Highlands Fire Hydrant Project – Your Rate Dollars at Work

Tahoe City Public Utility District is pleased to announce that on August 30, 2010, construction began on the installation of 14 new fire hydrants in the Highlands subdivision. Installation of these hydrants will bring the spacing of hydrants up to current fire code standards. Funding for this project is a combination of your water rate revenue and Federal grant funding.

Construction will extend from September to approximately October 15th. During the project there will be localized water outages lasting for a period of several hours. Property owners will be noticed 24-48 hours in advance of those anticipated outages, but it is not unusual for there to be unanticipated short-term outages due to construction issues.
