

# **Bambi Buck-A-Roos – Summer 2011**

*Bambi Camp is a youth day camp offered for children ages 3.5 - 5 years old. This camp is designed to introduce the pre-school child to the day camp experience, offering a safe, stimulating and creative environment for campers through programmed activities. Activities each week include arts and crafts, games, songs, and water play.*

**Dates:** Weekly sessions, June 23 through August 18, Monday through Friday

**Price:** \$134 per session for residents - \$144 per session for non residents  
Check with the Recreation Office for drop in prices and availability.

**Hours:** 9:00am - 12:30pm

**Location:** Skylandia Park, Lake Forest – Drop-off and pick-up at parking lot at corner of Lake Forest and Aspen.

**Signing In/Out:** When checking in your child, please park your car and walk him/her to the Bambi counselors. Please send a note if your child is to be picked up by anyone other than a parent. Camp ends at 12:30pm sharp. A \$1 fee will be charged for every minute you are late picking up your child.

**Food:** Please send a lunch every day labeled with your child's name. Also, a small bottle of ice water helps a lot! In an effort to help teach environmental awareness, we ask that you try to pack a lunch that will result in as little litter or waste as possible.

**Clothing:** Each child must wear closed toe shoes and socks (no sandals), and should bring a swimsuit and towel daily. It is best if campers wear their swimsuits under their clothes. All personal items should be labeled. Sunscreen and a hat are always a good idea! (It is best if sunscreen is applied at home.) Also, water shoes are highly recommended! Please pack all your child's belongings in a backpack or other carrier that is easily manageable.

**Rain:** During short thundershowers, we will do our best to shelter the children. However, due to a lack of indoor facilities, camp will be canceled if it is raining hard. If in doubt, call the Parks and Recreation office after 8am, or go pick them up.

**Overnighter:** No overnighter or extended care for Bambi Buck-A-Roos.
