

# **CIT - Summer 2011**

## ***Counselor in Training***

*The CIT Program is designed for those campers (6<sup>th</sup>-9<sup>th</sup> grade) that are interested in becoming Junior Counselors. CIT's will learn what it takes to become an outstanding camp counselor. This will include learning creative techniques to lead games, arts and crafts and more. Following safety procedures, problem solving/conflict resolution, and leadership skills will also be learned. CIT's will be matched up with camp counselors and also play an important roll in planning Friday special events. CIT's will attend Wednesday field trips and will also take a second trip during the week. Maximum of 13 CIT's will be accepted per week.*

**Dates:** Weekly sessions, June 23 through August 18, Monday through Friday  
\* **Please Note: There is no camp on Friday, August 19, due to overnigher.**

**Price:** \$105 per session for residents - \$115 per session not residents  
Check with the Recreation office for drop-in prices and availability.

**Hours:** 9:00am - 3:30pm – Field trip days may require a late pick up.

**Location:** Skylandia Park, Lake Forest – Drop-off and pick-up at parking lot at corner of Lake Forest and Aspen. CIT's must be picked up by a legal guardian at the end of the day unless camp staff is notified otherwise.

**Food:** Please send a BIG lunch every day labeled with your child's name. Also, a bottle of water helps a lot! In an effort to help teach environmental awareness, we ask that you try to pack a lunch that will result in as little litter or waste as possible.

**Clothing:** Each child must wear closed toe shoes and socks (no sandals), and should bring a swimsuit and towel daily. Sunscreen, a hat, and flip flops or water shoes are always a good idea for beach time. Staff will encourage all campers to reapply sunscreen, but will not apply for them.

**Rain:** During short thundershowers, we will do our best to shelter the children. However, due to a lack of indoor facilities, camp will be canceled if it is raining hard. If in doubt, call the Parks and Recreation office after 8am, or pick them up.

**Field Trips:** Your child's enrollment in camp is his or her ticket to weekly field trips. Your transportation fees have been included with your initial registration. All trips are via TCPUD van or TTUSD bus. Please watch for weekly flyers each Monday detailing your child's week.

**Overnigher:** Our all-camp overnigher is scheduled for Thursday, August 11. It begins at 7pm and will end at 9am on Friday, August 12.. Campers should have dinner prior to attending. CIT's must enroll for the entire last session in order to attend the overnigher. No drop-ins will be allowed.
