

Kidz Club 2011 - 2012

Kidz Club is a recreation based afterschool program for children in kindergarten through 5th grade. This is an all inclusive program that is meant to provide recreation and enrichment opportunities to all participants in a safe and positive environment. The program will feature daily homework time and assistance, arts and crafts, active and passive games, enrichments activities, special events, and much more.

- Dates:** September, 6, 2011 – June 19, 2012. Program follows TTUSD school calendar. Holiday programs and snow day programs will be offered during holidays, vacation weeks, and snow days.
- Price:** \$150 for a 20 day punch card or \$12 per day drop-in. Scholarships and payment plans are available for those in need of financial assistance.
- Hours:** School dismissal until 5:30 PM daily. Program is open early for Kindergarteners and will open early for TTUSD minimum days.
- Location:** Rideout Community Center. 740 Timberland Lane, Tahoe City, CA 96145
- Transportation:** TTUSD busses provide transportation to Rideout Community Center from all schools. The Rec Departments passenger van will also be used on occasion.
- Signing In/Out:** Parents must check their children out each day. At no time should a child leave without first notifying program staff. Please send a note if your child is to be picked up by anyone other than a parent. A \$1 fee will be charged for every minute you are late picking up your child.
- Food:** A healthy snack is provided daily. Please let program staff know of any food allergies. Cooking projects are also incorporated into the program so it is important to let staff know of any allergies.
- Clothing:** Please dress according to the weather each day. During the winter months we will be both inside and outside so snow boots and tennis shoes are recommended.
- Field Trips:** Throughout the year participants will have the option to attend field trips. These trips may include rock climbing, Squaw high camp, Incline Rec Center, etc. Please pay attention to flyers handed out to your children with information regarding trips.
- Special Events:** In order to provide the most opportunities for participants, staff will plan special events and parties. These will include holiday parties, field days, and other events. Staff members from All Fired Up, SWEP, and other community organizations will be apart of these events.
