



SOUPER SHOW DOWN RULES

Thank you for registering to participate in the first annual Tahoe City Parks & Recreation Souper Show Down. Below are some basic ground rules and instructions you will need to follow. 1. We cannot have open flames or burners at the event. All soups should be cooked ahead of time and brought to the event in an electric crock pot. You can bring extra soup if you would like. This is a first time event so we do not know how many people will be there to taste.
2. You supply your own ladle or serving spoon, we will supply the tasting cups. They are small cups probably 2-3 tablespoons.
3. There will be a professional category and a non-professional category. If you are representing a restaurant please present business cards, menus or anything to promote your restaurant. You are also welcome to decorate your table if you would like. Please make a sign with your name and soup. We will provide you with a number; please put that on your sign.
4. We are providing the tables. They are 8ft tables and you probably will be sharing the table with another person.
5. The event begins at 5:00 pm, cooks can arrive at 4:00 pm to set up and warm soup. Be advised to bring soup already warmed up.
6. At your table you will have room to have coolers and supplies behind the tables.
7. The event lasts until 8:00 pm and the awards will be given out at 8:30 pm. There will be official judging for a 1st, 2nd and a people's choice award. Separate prizes for non-professional and professional entries.
8. Our maximum entries will be limited to 10 professionals and 20 non-professional entries.
9. Please provide a list of ingredients to avoid food allergies. You can provide a recipe if you would like.
10. All soups must be homemade - no box mixes, etc.
