



# KIDS AFTERSCHOOL WOODSHOP

**WHO:** Kindergarten and 1st-5th graders.

**WHAT:** Students learn practical woodworking skills.

Instructors and students abide by strict safety procedures. Students choose from a wide range of projects supplied by the teacher and are encouraged to invent and design projects from their imagination. Children develop abstract reasoning capabilities and fine motor skills. They also learn about fractions and geometry and integrate them into their projects.
