

KIDZ CLUB

This all inclusive After School Recreation Program that is open to all children within Tahoe Truckee Unified School District. The Kidz Club is designed for children in Kindergarten through 5th grade.

The program is located at Rideout Community Center, 740 Timberland Lane, 3 miles south of Tahoe Lake School on the West Shore.



The Program

- Homework or quiet time will be part of the daily format.
- Weekly themes with related games and activities will be offered.
- Outdoor athletic field and open space area for a variety of sports and environmental opportunities.
- Time for free play or choice time to develop creative outlets.
- Enrichment activities will be integrated into the programs such as; music, dance, sports, arts & crafts. There will be specialized guest instructors that will be available for demonstrations and offer additional fee-based classes.
- Field trips will be taken to showcase some local attractions.
- A nutritionally balanced snack will be offered each day.

Transportation

- TTUSD will be offering the elementary age and Kinder students bus service to Rideout Community Center.

Enrollment and Fees

- **Punch Cards:** \$80 for 10 sessions, \$150 for 20 sessions.
- **Times:** Kindergarten 1:30—3:30 pm. Elementary 3:30—5:30 pm
- Punch card payments are due the first day of attendance.
- No refunds, pro-rated payments, or transfers are allowed. No

- refunds for suspensions, expulsions or no shows.
- Initial registration / emergency data form must be sent by mail or in person at the Recreation Office, located at 740 Timberland Lane, Tahoe City, CA 96145
- Subsequent punch card payments will be accepted by mail or in person at the Recreation Office, or by phone with Visa, Mastercard or American Express.
- Make checks payable to *Tahoe City PUD*.
- Program does not cover snow days, holidays or school vacations. Other programs will be offered during these times.

- The program does not dispense medication, it only provides ice packs or bandages for minor injuries. For emergencies staff will call the paramedics.

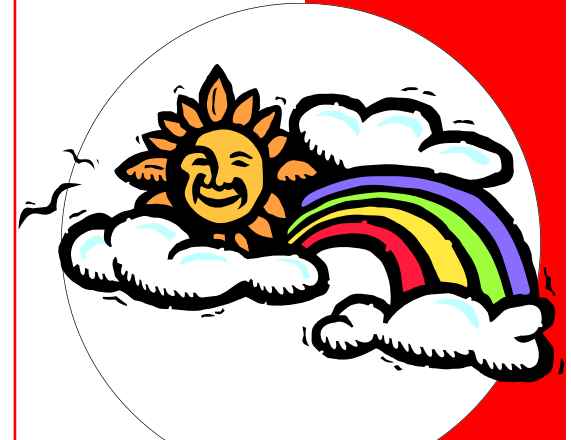
