LAKE FOREST CAMPGROUND

- ❖ If attendant is not on duty at the Lake Forest Boat Ramp Kiosk, use drop box (Iron Ranger) for payment (\$30 per night). Iron Ranger checked daily.
- ❖ **NO RESERVATIONS** are accepted. First-come, first-served basis only.
- ❖ Fee \$30 per night, with ten (10) day maximum stay.
- ❖ Check out time is 11:00am. Please remove all trash before leaving. There is a dumpster available – Please be sure to LATCH IT SHUT. Check the fire pit. If used distinguish it completely. Water/water pale is available by the Porta Potty and freeze proof faucet.
- ❖ Check in time is based on availability.
- ❖ 20 campsites for tents and campers. Dependent on spring run-off.
- ❖ Limit 30 feet for self-contained motor homes. 25 feet for trailer length. Truck/trailer combo must be disconnected inside the campground area. **NO HOOKUPS** available.
- ❖ Portable restrooms are located in the campground. Flush toilets are available at Pomin Park.
- ❖ **NO SHOWERS, NO HOOKUPS, NO DUMPING STATIONS.**
- ❖ Dogs OK on leash. Dogs must always be attended to and cannot be left alone in campsite. Pick up after your dog and dispose of poop bag in trash.
- ❖ BBQ's, fire pits and tables are available at most campsites. During "RED FLAG" warning days and/or when Tahoe Basin fire restrictions are in effect, absolutely no burning will be allowed. Please check campground front entrance notice board for updates.
- ❖ Fire pits must never be left unattended and must be fully extinguished before you leave.
- ❖ Be BEAR AWARE with food and trash.
- ❖ Water spigot in campground is located by the dumpster.
- ❖ Additional parking for paid campground sites only – limit 2 vehicles per campsite.
- ❖ Quiet Hours 10pm – 7am
