



Public Notice

On January 30, 2019, TCPUD utility crews discovered a disruption in the Dollar – Edgewater sewer line running along the shoreline below Edgewater Drive in the Dollar Point community. The affected portion of sewer line is between 40-60 feet and serves 17 homes. Staff have responded immediately to mitigate the situation and notify appropriate regulatory agencies. TCPUD crews have capped the existing line and installed a by-pass, effectively containing the sewer system and ensuring no disruption to service. We do not believe there is currently a public health risk and we are performing complete testing near the affected area. Preliminary investigation by the District indicates wave action produced by recent storm activity exposed the existing sewer line and caused a portion of the line to become detached. The District is working ahead of the upcoming storm to declare an emergency and initiate repairs. The repair work is weather dependent and could take 7-10 days to complete. The District will provide updates as more information becomes available.
