



Dear Parents,

On behalf of the Tahoe City PUD Parks & Recreation Department, the camp staff would like to welcome you and your child(ren) to a summer of Camp Sky Lil' Pines at the Tahoe City Community Center (TCCC), a "branch" of Camp Skylandia! Our camp has over 25 years of summer tradition and we will strive to keep that tradition growing while leaving our own impression for years to come. **Please note, on sessions C (July 6-9) and F (July 27-30), there is no camp on Fridays, after the Thursday Camp Movie Nights/ "Parents' Night Out" at Camp Skylandia.**

Each week we will feature a different theme, and your child will participate in a variety of group games both active and passive, arts and crafts, water play and other enrichment activities. For Camp, please pack for fun in the sun and a large lunch! Dress-up day is at the end of each week, and we encourage campers and staff to dress up for our camp theme and show off their creativity!

Please remember to pack these important items for your child every day:

Campers will be issued a clear storage container marked with their name to store their personal belongings. To alleviate a large lost and found collection, please remember to write your child's name on everything they bring to camp including hats, bags, lunch boxes, towels, sweatshirts, etc.

- Sack Lunch and Snacks
- Water Bottle (Campers must have their own refillable water bottle and staff will assist in refilling empty water bottles)
- Sunscreen
- Closed-Toe Shoes
- Water Shoes for Water Play
- Bathing Suit and Towel for Water Play (It is recommended that your child comes prepared wearing their suit under their clothes).

Camp Skylandia Movie Nights/ "Parents' Night Out":

Have some fun and catch a movie under the stars! New, this summer are our Camp Skylandia Movie Nights aka "Parents' Night Out" evenings and are scheduled for Thursday July 9 and Thursday July 30. These evenings are in lieu of our past camp overnights and are optional for Pinecones (aka Kinders), grades 1-6, and CITs. Campers will attend camp all day and be picked up at 3:30pm to go home, have dinner and grab items for the Movie Night. **Our Camp Movie Nights will be held at Skylandia Beach with drop-off at 7:00pm.** We will not be providing dinner but will have snacks for movies and activities. **Campers will then be picked up at 10pm after the movie. Please remember, there is NO CAMP on the Fridays after the Movie Nights/ "Parents' Night Out" (Friday July 10 and Friday July 31).** For the Movie Nights, campers are more than welcome to wear comfy and warm clothes and a blanket/mat to snuggle with or lay on to watch the movie!

Drop-Off and Pick-Up Procedures:

Drop-Off and Pick-Up will be at the **Tahoe City Community Center, 401 West Lake Blvd. next to Tahoe Tree Company (map included below).**

Drop-Off Times:

- Between 9:00am and 9:30am
- For Camp Skylandia Movie Nights: 7:00pm at Skylandia Park and Beach, Corner of Lake Forest Rd. and Aspen St.

Pick-Up Times:

- Half-Day option for Seedlings, Between 12:00pm and 12:30pm
- Full-Day for Seedlings & Pinecones, Between 3:00pm and 3:30pm
- For Camp Skylandia Movie Nights: 10:00pm at Skylandia Park and Beach, Corner of Lake Forest Rd. and Aspen St.

We do recognize that traffic may be an issue. If a situation arises where you may be late in picking up, please call our office (530-583-3440 ext. 2) and let us know as soon as possible. If you have someone other than the person who dropped off your child pick them up, please let camp staffers know as soon as possible.
